A number of control system settings can be accessed via a "Hidden Menu" on the control panel, which is accessed as follows:

First turn & hold the **thermal lock key** in the override position.

Next, press the time **up** or **down** keys and release the thermal lock key.

1 should now be displayed on the temperature display and by default **0** will displayed on the time display.

Using the temperature up key scroll through from **1** to **13** in the temperature display.

The function and setting of the individual settings are as follows:

After no keys are pressed for eight seconds the display returns to normal.

*For the Delay Start Timer, the time is set in real time; therefore the Main Board clock has to be correctly set for this to work properly.

After one delayed start operation, delayed start automatically switches off, and the autoclave returns to normal operation

These settings only apply where the autoclave is fitted with this functionality.
